Wooden Memorial Post Specification

Specification: Memorial Style Wooden Post with Mounted Plaques

General Description

A vertical wooden memorial post constructed from a single solid timber section. The post is designed to stand 1.3 metres above ground level with an additional 500 mm embedded below ground for stability, bringing the total length of the timber to 1.8 metres.

Materials

- Timber Type: Seasoned hardwood (e.g., oak or treated larch) for durability in outdoor environments.
- Finish: Natural weathered or oiled finish, optional light sanding to retain rustic character.
- Dimensions:
- Height: 1.8 metres total
- 1.3 metres above ground
- 0.5 metres below ground
- Width: Approximately 250 mm
- Thickness: 100mm 150 mm

Structural Details

- Top: Flat or slightly rounded top edge
- Mounting Method: Direct burial into earth, secured with concrete or post-crete to a depth of $500 \ \mathrm{mm}$

Plaque Mounting Configuration


- Number of Plagues: Up to 18–20 small memorial plagues
- Plaque Size: Each approximately 100 mm x 50 mm (brass or anodised aluminium)
- Arrangement: Neatly spaced in columns (single or double), affixed using rust-resistant screws or rivets
- Label Area: Option to have title or main dedication plaque at the top, slightly larger than the rest

Environmental Suitability

- Outdoor Durability: Timber must be treated or naturally resistant to rot and insect damage
- Location Suitability: Suitable rural commemorative installations

Installation Instructions

- 1. Excavate a 500 mm deep hole of \sim 300 mm diameter.
- 2. Place post in centre and backfill with fast-setting concrete.
- 3. Ensure post is plumb and allow concrete to cure before mounting plaques.
