

EDITORIAL 180

As Editor I'd like to pay a tribute to all the volunteers in Willand who make our village a lovely place to live. From the Parish Council, Willand Village Hall, Willand Health & Community Centre, Willand Pantry, Willand Magazine, Willand Rovers, Willand Composting Scheme, The Schools helpers, Our Churches, The Tennis Club, The Youth Club, Scouts Beavers and Cubs, to name just a few and all the other clubs and associations who report their activities in this magazine. Apologies if I've missed you out but you are all greatly appreciated. So, this month we Salute your unselfish commitment to making our Village a special place to live. **Thank You. Sam Fincher.** 

### PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S NOTES

As I write this in the cool of the early morning I hope that the rest of you are managing to cope with the hot weather. Some relish it but I must admit to being one who likes things when it is a bit cooler. I have been watching some of the tennis from Wimbledon and feel for the players and the spectators. I expect they are glad when the roof is closed, and the air conditioning is on.

In spite of the limited rainfall everything seems to be growing, and garden bushes and hedges are beginning to encroach on the footpaths. It is the landowner's responsibility to cut back and leave the pavements and footpaths clear. At the end of the day Devon County Council have the final responsibility and they have the powers to require landowners to cut back and clear up and if they do not the Council can do it and charge the landowner. The Parish Council do approach landowners, but we can only seek their cooperation. The fun begins when the land is believed to belong to Mid Devon District Council, and they say it belongs to Devon County Council. We then get a pass the parcel start but I do try and stop the music. It helps if everyone who encounters a problem reports it to Devon County Council and remember to copy in your County Councillor and where relevant, District Councillors.

You may have noticed that there are surveys and discussions going on about doing away with the County Council and District Councils and forming just two or three councils to cover Devon – in my book that also includes Plymouth. Please make your views known. The Parish Council are trying to find out how this will affect us locally and it is not an easy task to try and maintain local representation when things are bigger and further removed. We can be sure of one thing and that is it will cost us a lot more money. What will be 'dumped' onto town and parish councils and then professional staff will have to be employed to run it. Watch this space but make sure you take the opportunity to make your views known in the advertised survey. You never know, someone may listen and take note.

The Parish Council are now beginning the process of seeking contractors to start looking after the verges and certain play areas and open spaces. Weed spraying of the pavement edges and central islands and paviour road features are also being looked at. All the papers will be available to view on the Parish Website with the meeting papers so please let the Clerk know if you have any

thoughts. We do not meet in August so letting us know before our September meeting will be ideal.

Now I need to move into 'grumpy old git' mode. We are beginning to see minor, but still costly, incidents of criminal damage – because that is what it is – around the village. In the Jubilee Field the waste bin at the entrance to the Pump Track was forced from its fixings. The safety sign has been bent and damaged and forced from its fixings and discarded. The handyman repaired it, and someone has had another go at forcing it off. Netting put over the stones in the drains has been ripped up and made useless so will have to be replaced. All costing council taxpayers money. The only thing with this is that the culprits are on CCTV and have been passed to the police. If the parents of the young people would like to pay for the cost of the repairs/replacements then the Clerk would be pleased to hear from them. The fenced play areas are for the use of younger children. That being the case can someone please tell me why two women were seen riding the new spring see saw in the Jubilee Field. It is not designed to take such bulk. One of the other sprung rides in the same area has been broken off and had to be removed. I wonder if one of the ladies tried to ride this one. That item has had to be removed for safety, cannot be repaired, and so may not be replaced. What mindless so and so thought it would be fun to damage the Tiny Tots bear on the planter on the corner of Gables Road and Meadow Park? Moaning old git done.

The speed sign is still functioning and the reading for last month were similar in average, but the number of really fast speeds recorded had thankfully reduced. The information collected is shared with the police. We also have some Community Speed watch volunteers active in the village again, but they would be pleased for more help.

We have a community with a lot of assets which need to be looked after and with the school holidays coming there will be those who will fail to be amused unless they are destroying something. I notice that the Youth Club is not attracting sufficient secondary school aged youngsters to justify arranging sessions. This is sad as it will be a case of 'use it or lose it'. Those giving of their time to provide such a facility deserve better support than this.

Please, if you see someone causing damage, challenge them. If you do not feel confident enough to confront please try and recall enough information to identify the perpetrator – even take a picture. Report it to the police and in any case please contact the Parish Clerk with the information so that things can be made safe.

Those people who walk by and ignore trouble remind me of the parable of the good Samaritan where someone did do something – Luke Chapter 10 versus 24 to 37 if you are interested. I am not after the vicars job, but I thought I would prove to some that I do remember some things I was taught at primary school some 70 years ago. Remembering what I did this morning is another story. Keep smiling and have an enjoyable and safe summer. **Barry G J Warren.**

### FORMER TIVERTON SCHOOL STAFF LUNCH GROUP THRIVING

Tiverton School was created by the amalgamation of Tiverton Grammar School, Heathcoat Secondary School and Bampton Secondary Modern School in 1977 with an age-range of 13-18 (including a large sixth form). As Tiverton's first comprehensive school it operated as Tiverton's upper school in a three-tier system, being fed by pupils from five 9-13 middle schools; the youngest pupils attended first schools (5-9) until 1992, when the area changed from its three-tier, middle school system back to the current two-tier primary/secondary system and Tiverton School became Tiverton High School with its 11-16 age range.

The group, which includes non-teaching colleagues as well as teachers from Tiverton School and its predecessor schools, has almost forty members, mostly living locally but some travel greater distances to attend. The day the group meets rotates each month to enable everyone to attend whenever they can.

Most of the living former staff have been invited but the group, which includes teaching, support, administrative and premises staff, is still trying to locate these colleagues (and maybe others) if they are still alive:

### MID DEVON DISTRICT COUNCIL

Further to an article I wrote at the start of the year in relation to dog fouling, Mid Devon District Council has received a number of complaints with respect to the public litter bins, which are being used to dispose of household waste, either inside of the bin or alongside the bins.

We have also received reports of a fuel can being left inside a bin, and what appears to be business waste.

Not only is the above concerning in respect of public safety, it also prevents the bins from being used properly i.e. for the purpose of disposing litter. They are becoming fuller quicker, which can lead to littering issues and the area looking unsightly.

Household waste should be disposed of as per your normal collection dates, any household waste found within or around a public litter bin could lead to a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued.

If you have considerable waste requirements you may be eligible for a 2<sup>nd</sup> bin, information on this and how to apply can be found on Mid Devon District Council's website or by calling our Customer First Team on 01884 255255.



### WILLAND HISTORY GROUP

First of all, we would like to thank everyone who came along to our Archive Open Morning at the end of May. It was great to catch up with old friends and meet lots of new people, welcoming them to our community. The morning exceeded our expectations: new members joined, and new contacts were made, with much positive feedback, interest and engagement. We would especially like to thank everyone who brought along new information, plus kindly loaning us photos and documents, of which we are in the process of making copies for the Archive. There was so much that we have not seen before – for example, a brilliant group photo of Great Western Railway staff at Tiverton Junction railway station, taken in 1917/18, complete with a First World War army recruitment poster clearly visible on the wall in the background. It certainly gives us encouragement for the future of the History Group, but we are still few in number and there is lots to do – any help or support is much appreciated, so please do get in touch.

We look forward to expanding on all this enthusiasm through our Buildings Project, as many people were very interested in how much the parish has changed, even over the last few decades. We had fun trying to pin down and make a record of some of the more recent events – like exactly when the Willand Moor estate was built or even trying to remember when the Co-Op first opened. There was also interest in some of the big houses that we have recently lost – for example, Townlands house, knocked down in 1970/71 to make way for the Townlands estate, and The Gables, a much-loved part of Willand's landscape, demolished only ten years ago, over the winter of 2014/15.

Since the open morning, we have also received a couple of queries about Willand buildings that you may be able to help with. Firstly, the houses at the top of Dean Hill Road (to the south of the parish, backing onto the M5). Maps and aerial photo evidence suggests the first of these were built between the wars, and the rest at some time after the Second World War – can you tell us anything about these houses, when they were built, or do you have any photos of them? Secondly, the Somerlea estate: we know this was built as a council estate soon after Second World War, but can you tell us exactly when, or have any photos of the estate, or tell us who used to live where, or have any memories of Somerlea, maybe growing up there, that you would be happy to share?

Finally, 6 July saw the 340<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Battle of Sedgemoor, the last battle to be fought on English soil and the bloody culmination of the Monmouth Rebellion – an event of national significance, with a Willand connection. To give some background, the Duke of Monmouth, the exiled illegitimate son of the previous monarch, Charles II, had challenged the succession of his uncle, James II, a Catholic, because of fears that his religion threatened the established Protestant religion and the liberties of the English Parliament. After landing at Lyme Regis in June 1685 the Duke gathered an army of Westcountry men prepared to fight and die for their way of life and religion. They marched

north through Somerset and almost reached Bristol before turning back after skirmishes with Royalist forces and the onset by poor weather, returning to Bridgwater, closely followed by the main Royalist force. Despite fearing his cause was doomed, at dawn on 6 July 1685 Monmouth, a skilled and experienced military commander, attempted a surprise attack on the Royalist army encamped at Westonzoyland on the Somerset Levels. But the alarm was raised before Monmouth's troops could attack, and despite a brave fight Monmouth's amateur army was defeated by the king's professional soldiers at what became known as the Battle of Sedgemoor.

The aftermath of the battle was bloody, with the rebels cut down as they fled the battlefield, and then through the King's programme of retribution known as the 'Bloody Assizes', whereby the rebels, who had been rounded up, were put on trial and given harsh punishments by the ruthless Lord Chief Justice 'Judge' Jeffreys, Overall, around 300 men were sentenced to death and 800 were deported to the West Indies - around 26 Devon men were executed, through being hung drawn and quartered, with their body parts boiled and tarred, and publicly displayed as a warning; Monmouth himself was found hiding in a ditch many miles away and later beheaded. Amongst the list of rebels was one Thomas Ellis, yeoman, of Willand – there were also 12 men from Cullompton, and two from Uffculme. Our ongoing research suggests that Thomas Ellis was a farmer, although we do not yet know at which farm holding, and he left behind him a wife, Elizabeth, and at least two daughters. He escaped from the battle but was later captured and imprisoned in Wiltshire, and then put on trial at Wells in Somerset, where he was 'bound over', and so avoided the severest punishments.

Three hundred and forty years later there was again a Willand presence on the battlefield, as one member of History Group attended service commemorate the to anniversary, held at the Battle of Sedgemoor memorial, located close to the mass grave of so many of the rebels - there were prayers and hymns, and perhaps most poignantly the words contemporary folk song were read aloud: "Oh Lord, where is my husband now - Where once he stood beside me? - His body lies at Sedgemoor -In grave of oak and ivy". Thankfully,

this end did not befall Thomas Ellis, yeoman, of Willand, and his family, though undoubtedly their lives were changed forever by this ill-fated rebellion. **James Morrison**, 01884 250057 (jamorrison235@gmail.com)


