




EDITORIAL 181

Interestingly I have received a submission from Brian Holmes who was the Founder and original Editor of this magazine. He has sent us a copy of the second magazine (Shown below) I believe the first print run was 900 copies today it is 1650 copies.

Brian says, The October November is the thirtieth anniversary of its 'birth'. The VERY first edition was a folded-in-half sheet of A3 paper, a copy of which was delivered to every house in the parish in November 1995, by about a half dozen people. It's come a long way since then (and a lot of water under the bridge), the 'Amstrad' computer that was used to type it is long since gone. The original printers, Astra Print in Cullompton, moved away and have been taken over by, I think, the current printers. **Brian Holmes.**



PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S NOTES

Autumn is officially upon us and certainly the rain has returned with vengeance. Lawns look to be recovering in some places and the playing fields, and the allotments are looking pretty good and the latter productive. I am not looking forward to seeing the allotment water bill when it comes. It is a good job that our Clerk is good with our budgets.

There is quite a bit going on in the village which has resulted in residents contacting the Clerk and myself. The Facebook pages have also been active from time to time with some useful facts and the usual ill-informed comment from some. Our Council has had a 'descriptive word' used about it and one of the meanings given on Google certainly is not anatomically applicable to the male councillors.

As a follow on from last month with regard to damage and other anti-social behaviour in the village we hope that the situation will settle down now that the children are back at school. The damage, or the repair of it, has cost the council taxpayers money. Reports have been made to the police with no known action. The CCTV picture of offender(s) were not good enough for the police as he had a hoodie up. No thought of talking to other children who were in the picture but behaving. The Clerk has even had one response from the police that it was not 'proportionate' to do anything. It must be said it all seems to be coming out of a police office at Exeter without any contact from our local officers. Parish Council will be taking matters up with the Chief Constable and the Police and Crime Commissioner. It was interesting that there was a police presence when MDDC officers were talking to residents of Somerlea about clearing off their normal parking spaces to allow the builders to start. There might have been a problem apparently! We had problems and got no action on the ground.

We have had a number of contacts over the person sleeping in the red tent in the North corner of the Jubilee Field. I have been told by a resident that the police did visit the person, but they will be doing nothing. MDDC Homeless Team have made contact, but the person does not want their help. If the tent remains then it will cause problems for our contractors cutting the grass and hedges and so the Parish Council will have to look into whether or not removal will be sought under the law. More cost to us all if we follow that route.

Residents living in the vicinity of the Somerlea Housing project have had a number of problems with loss of parking, more parking on the grass verges and roads – some 20 cars spaces have been lost – delivery lorries, damage to pavements, times of working and a number of other breaches of planning conditions by the contractor. On behalf of the Parish Council, I have been chasing MDDC Planning Services supported by District Councillor Andrea Glover and the recent involvement of Councillor John Poynton. Responses have been mixed, and I have submitted formal complaints and am experiencing the anticipated prevarication and time delays. I had to smile when a direct complaint was responded to by thanking me for my 'feedback'. We are continuing to follow up our concerns with the relevant parties.

Parish Council are discussing trying to have more parking spaces made available on the grass verges, much as they did when they built houses on the car park in Fir Close. We chased this back in 2018 and MDDC Officers turned it down. Some of our paperwork will be on our website but if anyone wishes to know more please feel free to contact the Clerk or myself. Watch this space as they say.

Residents should have received a letter from a potential developer carrying out a public consultation prior to submitting an outline planning application for 130 houses on the land between Silver Street and the motorway and Fox Mill Gardens and the Esso Garage. The consultation at the village hall will have passed by the time you read this. As the process proceeds please make sure that you make your voices heard during the planning process. Please do not

leave it to others and then moan about it afterwards. We will have to await the detail to see how utilities will be provided for and what improvements or provision of infrastructure are going to be forthcoming. It is no good just saying we need more houses without ensuring that our current residents and any new ones do not have a reduction in quality of life. Just a couple of thoughts of my own press for the speed limit on the main road to be reduced to 30mph it was promised when Fox Mill Gardens, Ash Close and Rowan Lea were approved but not happened yet. We could also press for the footpath out to the garage to be widened to a minimum of 3m to become a pedestrian and cycle space. Will not need a hedge to keep growing out over it and restricting it though.

We have received some positive responses as to the work for the inclusion of a wildflower meadow at the cemetery. Our new contractors seem to be settling in now but if there are any problems please contact the Clerk in preference to offensive comment on Facebook. It does not help to write negative or insulting remarks on Facebook.

Moving from wildflowers to weeds. It will be known that the parish council have had the weeds, which grow in the pavement kerb edges and the road paviours, sprayed twice a year to try and keep things looking tidy and it also prevents some of the weeds growing larger and damaging the pavements or paviours. Up until, and including, this year our County Councillor has contributed roughly half the cost from his allocated locality budget. We have now heard that this help will not be available next year. To continue will mean a cost to the Parish of over £1,500.00 per year. We are aware that some in the village do not want the weeds sprayed to allow more scope for the wildlife to feed. Others want things to look tidy and not to have damaged pavements or road surfaces – all Devon County Council Highways matters. The question is – do residents want the Parish Council, on residents behalf, to continue with the weed spraying? Please respond to the Clerk by email or telephone to help us decide what you want and what is best. Please do not leave it to others and then moan afterwards.

We still have a vacancy on the Parish Council if you are interested. It would be great to have one of the younger members of the community join us. If you are over 18 years old you would be really welcome.

The Bluebell café has changed owner, and we wish Sue a pleasant retirement. Good luck to the new owners and I hope that the venue will still be available as a meeting venue with outside people. The quality of the Bacon Baps and the coffee will need to be maintained!

Before you know it preparations will be being made for Christmas, and I have already seen notifications for Christmas Fairs. Please do your best to support all the events you can within the village as this is what keeps our community going. Oh yes it does just practicing for the pantomime in the New Year.





ST. MARY'S CHURCH HARVEST FESTIVAL

During the month of October, we will be celebrating the Harvest Festival at St Mary's. The primary function of this event is to thank God for his faithfulness and provision. Back in ancient Israel, it was the custom to wave the first fruits of the harvest and place them before God in thanksgiving and faith that He would continue to provide. The people engaging in this worship were subsistence farmers who had to ek out a living from year to year in tough times. Life was hard! Alongside this, these struggling farmers were called to leave some of the harvest for the poor. God commanded them not to reap to the very edge of the field and not to go twice over the fruit trees and vines. All this equated to trusting in God, that as they acted honourably, He would honour them.

I know that there are so many challenges facing the farmers who grow the food we eat. In the most recent series of Clarkson's Farm, viewers get to see the impact of unpredictable weather. Jeremy finds out that his Durum wheat crop has too low a Hagberg rating to be used for pasta. He comments saying, "imagine if the success of a surgeon's work depended on the weather! In fact, imagine being in any line of work that was so dependent upon the weather." He has a point that there is no other line of work that relies so heavily upon having the right weather at the right time. Jeremy is fortunate that his livelihood does not rest upon the success of his farm, but he does want to run a successful business. However, other farmers are not so fortunate to have the celebrity backing he does.

As I walk around our village, and see the fields full of crops or herds, I am constantly reminded that farming is at the centre of our community. In view of this, I want to say a big thank you to our local farmers who work hard to provide home-grown food.

As part of our Harvest Festival services, we will give thanks to God for those who work to produce the food we eat. We will thank God for how blessed we are to live in a country where food is so readily available. Finally, we'll bring gifts of food for CHAT (Churches Housing Action Team) to benefit those who struggle to put food on the table. This year we are going to have two Harvest celebrations in Willand. One will be a more traditional service in St Mary's Church on Sunday the 5th of October. The other will be an informal family friendly service in the Church Hall on Sunday the 12th of October. Even if you don't usually attend church, please feel free to come along to either of these services and acknowledge the harvest season. **Reverend Ben Maynard**


