# To ratify the following planning application submissions agreed since the last Full Council meeting:

- i. To recommend refusal on application number 25/01356/TPO, application to reduce the lateral limb of one Ash tree by 2m and reduce the crown by 1.5-2m protected by Tree Preservation Order 97/00008/TPO, for the following reasons: no site location plan to give clear indication of location of tree, no arboriculturist report, no evidence of damage or disease to tree or likely damage to property, no reason given to justify the works requested.
- ii. To make no observations on application number 25/00823/FULL, construction of a drainage pond to serve employment development, land at NGR 303516 111580, Tancock Business Park Four Cross Avenue.
- iii. To comment as follows on application number 25/01422/TPO, application to monolith 1 Ash tree (T1) and remove limb of 1 Ash tree (T2) and reduce remainder of tree by 2-3m, protected by Tree Preservation Order 97/00008/TPO: Willand Parish Council notes that there are two conflicting application forms on the portal and does not support this application as it is currently presented information is sparse, in particular there is no arboriculturist report providing clear reasons for the proposed work including evidence of disease or likely damage to property.
- iv. To comment as follows on application number 25/01433/TPO, application to reduce upper canopy of 1 Oak tree (T1) by 1.5-2m, MDC 50mm; reduce lowest limb at 4.5mm above ground level on western aspect by 3m to right angle growth, MDC 100mm and crown lift 1 Oak Tree (T3) to 2.5m above footpath and 5m above Plum Way; protected by Tree Preservation Order 96/00014/TPO: Willand Parish Council supports the application with regards to the work required to comply with the Highways Act to ensure there is adequate clearance for the road and footpath. The Parish Council will

support the views and recommendations of the Mid Devon District Council Tree Officer.

v. To make no observations on application number 25/01451/HOUSE, erection of a single storey rear extension and store to side at The Haven Willand Old Village EX15 2RW.
